Member Commitment

I, _____ commit to a membership with Added Value's Red Hook Community Supported Agriculture (RHCSA) for the 2014 Harvest Season. As a member I commit myself to supporting the farm with timely payments. In addition, I commit to pick up my weekly delivery at the Red Hook Farmer's Market from 10-3:00 pm every Saturday, beginning June 21st and ending November 15th. I understand that if I do not pick up my share it will be donated to an emergency food provider. I do not expect to have my share saved.

Additionally, I understand that as a Red Hook CSA member, I am also committed to contributing 9 hours of my time to supporting the Red Hook CSA by participating in farm work and/or other organizational projects. I will complete these hours by November 1. I cannot join the 2015 season until I complete these hours.

In return for my investment with the RHCSA, I will receive a weekly share consisting of approximately 6-10 items or bunches of vegetables. If I have opted for the fruit, cheese and/or egg share, I will receive a weekly share, in addition to my vegetable share. The variety, weight and size of both vegetable and fruit shares will vary depending on the time of the season. I understand that as a member of the RHCSA, I share in the inherent risks of agriculture (poor weather, drought, disease, early frost, crop failure and so on) and rewards (the bounty from a good season) involved in farming. We purposely plan for such contingencies, and use growing techniques that protect the harvest, minimize risk to members, and optimize the rewards. Moreover, the RHCSA builds relationships of trust between the farmers communities. By becoming a member of RHCSA, I am supporting the local farmer as well as more equitable food system and I am helping to create a more environmentally just, economically fair and healthy society. Therefore, I understand this principle and agree that there is no guarantee on the exact amount or type of produce I will receive in my share.
